
BOAT CRUISES

ABOUT ZANZIBAR

Zanzibar is an archipelago, situated off the coast of Tanzania in East Africa and surrounded by the warm Indian Ocean. It comprises a number of small islands and two larger ones, namely Unguja – also informally referred to as Zanzibar – and Pemba Island. Zanzibar is fondly referred to as the "Spice Islands" as the production of cloves, nutmeg, cinnamon and black pepper that takes place here.

This region, due to its proximity to the Equator, remains warm throughout the year and has equal days and nights which each last 12 hours. Exploring the islands and relaxing on Zanzibar's white sand beaches can be enjoyed to the fullest extent as the archipelago enjoys abundant sunshine.
